Because of my chains, most of the brothers in the Lord have been encouraged to speak the Word God more courageously and fearlesslysome preach Christ out of envy and rivalry, but others out of goods. The latter do so in lovethe former preach Christ out of selfish ambition, not sincerely, supposing that to can stir up trouble for me while I am in chains. But what does it matter? The important thing is that in every, whether from false motives or true, Christ is preached. And because of this I rejoice.
