The Collection for the Lord's People

¹ Now about the collection for the Lord's people: Do what I told the Galatianchurches to do. ² On the first day of every week, each one of you should set aside a sum of money in keeping with your income, saving it up, so that when I come no collections will have to be made. ³ Then, when I arrive, I will give letters of introduction to the men you approve and send them with your gift to Jerusalem. ⁴ If it seems advisable for me to go also, they will accompany me.

LOCATION

The letter was addressed to the Christian community in Corinth (modern day Greece). Paul started the church in Corinth in his second missionary journey (see Acts 18) and stayed there for 1.5 years.

BACKGROUND

Corinth benefited from its geographical location as a trading hub, attracting people from all over in considerable numbers, and bringing with them their cultures and religion.



The church suffered from division, moral lapses, practices concerning idol offerings, problems with display of spiritual gifts, conduct of worship, and confusion over the resurrection.






