He is ordained as a diaconal minister in the Chinese Annual Conference of the Methodist Church in Singapore and is attached to Bukit Panjang Methodist Church. His research interests are in colonial missions history of Southeast Asia (Singapore) and the missions history of East Asia (particularly Japanese Christianity).

Scripture Text

English Services at 8.30AM and 10.30AM

2 Corinthians 4:1-18

¹ Therefore, having this ministry by the mercy of God, we do not lose heart. ² We have renounced disgraceful, underhanded ways; we refuse to practice cunning or to tamper with God's word, but by the open statement of the truth we would commend ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. ³ And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled only to those who are perishing. ⁴ In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the likeness of God. ⁵ For what we preach is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake. ⁶ For it is the God who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.

⁷ But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, to show that the transcendent power belongs to God and not to us. ⁸ We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; ⁹ persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed; ¹⁰ always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be manifested in our bodies. ¹¹ For while we live we are always being given up to death for Jesus' sake, so that the life of Jesus may be manifested in our mortal flesh. ¹² So death is at work in us, but life in you.

¹³ Since we have the same spirit of faith as he had who wrote, “I believed, and so I spoke,” we too believe, and so we speak, ¹⁴ knowing that he who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and bring us with you into his presence. ¹⁵ For it is all for your sake, so that as grace extends to more and more people it may increase thanksgiving, to the glory of God.

¹⁶ So we do not lose heart. Though our outer nature is wasting away, our inner nature is being renewed every day. ¹⁷ For this slight momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, ¹⁸ because we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen; for the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.

HOW MANY LETTERS TO CORINTH?

Although the New Testament contains only two letters to the Corinthian church, the evidence from 1 and 2 Corinthians suggests that Paul wrote at least four letters to Corinth.

- 1. 1 Corinthians 5:9 refers to an early letter, sometimes called the "warning letter".
- 2. 1 Corinthians
- 3. The "letter of tears", referred to by Paul in 2 Corinthians 2:3-4 and 7:8.
- 4. 2 Corinthians

Paul wrote 2 Corinthians from Macedonia in response to the Corinthians repenting from a previous letter written with "anguish and tears".

PAUL'S MESSAGE

The book of 2 Corinthians is rich with theological insights and practical applications, centered around several key themes:



Believers should not rely on their strength but on God's power working through vulnerabilities.



Christians must share about God's grace and live out the reconciling work of the gospel in all relationships.



Generosity is a mark of grace for believers and an expression of thanksgiving to God.



The new covenant enables believers to reflect the Lord's glory and be transformed into His image

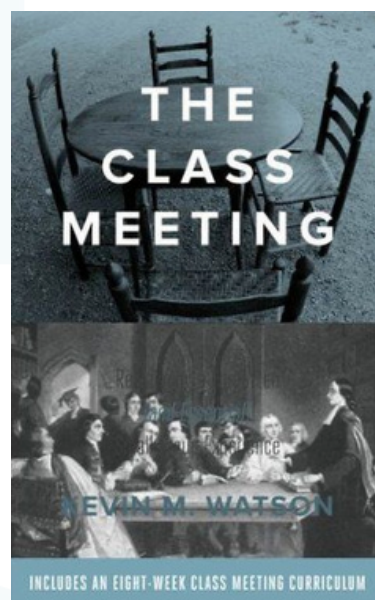

As I reflect on the many conversations I had over this mission trip with the missionaries, I am truly blessed to hear and see how God so loves His people and empowers them to love others. The stories that they shared echoed the specific calling they had from God and because of their love for Him, they were obedient to that call to serve in Timor-Leste. God is indeed at work, to see how He has led David and his family to start a school here. To see how God has guided them over these years to grow the school from 18 students to more than 700 students. May each student that come encounter God personally, may they be a generation of Timorese who love God and love others.

I was also blessed by the students who attended the sewing lessons we conducted. They were eager to learn and tried their best to do each step well.





They stayed beyond the time allocated and persevered to finish sewing the bag or pencil pouch. I was also touched to hear how the students sing their school song from their hearts and also how they sang praises to God during worship with no inhibitions.

I'm also thankful for the team that God brought together, each of us with our individual talents and strengths, united by God's love. As we surrender to God the gifts He blessed us with, He can multiply it and use it for His good purpose. In preparing for this trip, my faith grew as I saw how God provided us with all that we needed, from the safe and on time flights to the funds. From ideas to construct the bag to the help that we had to film a teaching video. Indeed we are blessed to be adopted children of God who are loved by Him and called to love others. There is much work to be done in Timor-Leste, may many more be willing to go, to pray and to love the Timorese.

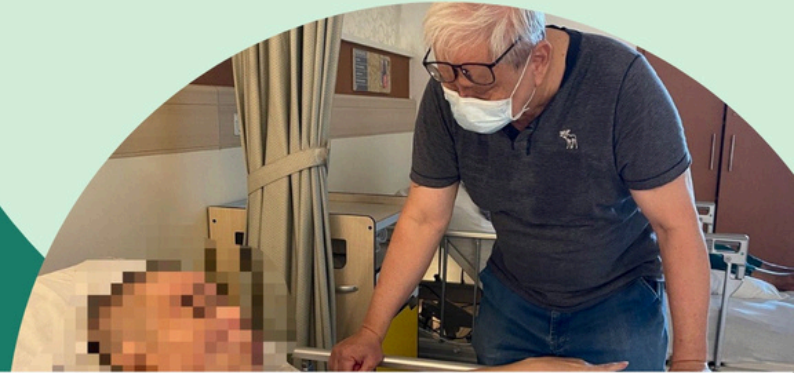
