

Season of Advent

The word "Advent" comes from the Latin word "adventus" which means "coming" or "visit." It begins four Sundays before Christmas and ends on Christmas Eve. During Advent, we prepare for, and anticipate, the coming of Jesus Christ. We remember the longing of Jews for a Messiah and our own longing for, and need of, forgiveness, salvation and a new beginning. Even as we look back and celebrate the birth of Jesus in a humble stable in Bethlehem, we also look forward anticipating the second coming of Christ as the fulfilment of all that was promised by His first coming. The liturgical colour is purple, symbolising penitence and royalty.

Fourth Candle - Love

The fourth Advent candle symbolizes Love. It signifies Jesus Christ as God's greatest gift of love.

- ¹ After the king was settled in his palace and the Lord had given him rest from all his enemies around him, ² he said to Nathan the prophet, "Here I am, living in a house of cedar, while the ark of God remains in a tent."


