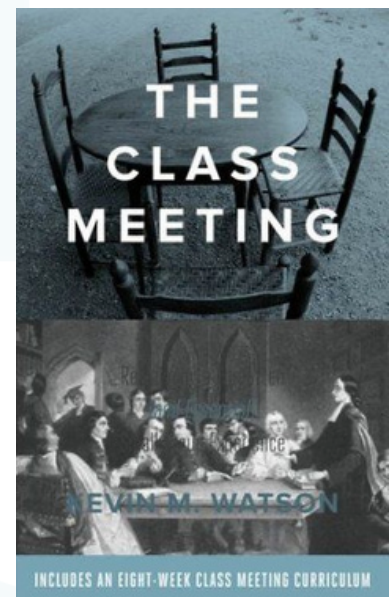

It felt like a home coming when we drove into the school compound of St Paul Methodist School (SPMS). Having visited the ministry three times before, that moment felt surreal as it was the fulfilment of what the Lord spoke of “to build a school without walls”. The singing of the school song by the Girls’ Brigade girls touched my heart as I felt that it was a declaration to make a difference in their land.

Lastly it was seeing the students whom I taught sewing last year that really warmed my heart. I could see their confidence in using the sewing machines and how they were all so eager to learn the drawstring backpack project.



Their mastery of the skill showed me that it is possible to see a lasting effect in the small things that we teach to the students in SPMS.

I want to encourage church members to go to Timor to see the work God is doing in this place and plant more seeds of growth in this land.

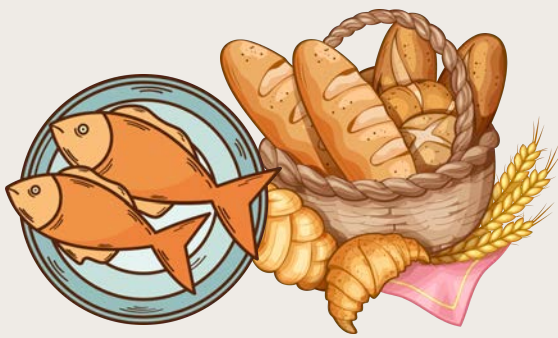
Mission Trip Reflection

I had heard so much about this beautiful country. But there was nothing like experiencing it for myself.

When I first found out about the mission trip, I wasn't sure if I could contribute since the original focus was to conduct sewing classes at St Paul Methodist School.

But I decided to offer whatever experience I had – namely writing and teaching God's Word – which the Lord used in ways beyond what I could think of.

As it turned out, our church's missionary David Chan, who is also the school's principal, already had a desire to start an editorial newsletter. He was also keen for his final-year students (Grade 12) and trainee teachers awaiting university enrolment to practise their English.

More than just imparting skills, I'm thankful that I was able to build relationships with my class of 16 students. Getting to know them, understanding their hopes and dreams, and learning how the school has made a difference in their lives, were all precious moments.

I also had the opportunity to speak to the Girls' Brigade students and share my testimony on dating and how God helped me understand the meaning of love.

Who would have thought that the Lord could use whatever that I have been through to encourage young ladies in Timor-Leste? Indeed, when we offer up our five loaves and two fishes, He multiplies it so that others can be fed.

I also saw the multiplier effect in the lives of the missionaries there.

Hearing the stories of courageous men and women who have given up the comforts of home and answered the call to serve in a foreign land, and seeing how God has used them to touch the lives of many Timorese, are truly a testament to kingdom math.



It was incredible to witness David's three children working alongside their parents – there's something so moving about seeing a family serving in missions together. The five of them are now making disciples who will then go on to make more disciples!

In Timor-Leste, the needs are many.



How fast the school will grow, how wide our ministry will reach, how deep our impact will be... all that will depend on how many of us are willing to come alongside and be counted.

I hope to continue supporting our missionaries and ministry in Timor-Leste with my five loaves and two fishes, and I pray that more of us can consider doing so too.

May we all also have the chance to marvel at how our God can do greater things than we can ever imagine.

NFF Update

The Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF) is gearing up for the National Family Festival (NFF) throughout the month of June, coinciding with the school holidays. This festival boasts an array of engaging events held from 25 May to 17 June at Gardens by the Bay, and on several June weekends at different venues on our island.

It is an opportune moment for churches to take the lead in promoting strong family values within their communities, aligning with the ethos that Christians uphold beyond merely addressing negative family issues. Here are some ways in which churches can work with MSF:

- Plan camps, programmes and activities in June that emphasise the importance of family bonds. MSF can provide support through materials and parent-child activity kits.
- Coordinate with MSF to reserve slots for church members to participate in NFF events, ensuring that they can actively engage in the festivities.
- Integrate church family-centric events with the broader offerings of the NFF, maximising synergy and community involvement.
- Publicise family activities leveraging church communication channels to encourage members' participation using MSF's marketing kit as in this [LINK](#).

We encourage churches to plan their June activities with NFF in mind.

The Annual General Meeting

of NCCS was held on 25 April. The AGM for the 2023-2025 term of office was held at the Chapel For All Peoples, St Andrew's Cathedral since our office was not large enough to accommodate the attendance of more than 40 persons. Members heard the President, Bishop Lu Guan Hoe's message and presentations of several reports, including the Council's representative to the Board of Visitors for SAF Detention Barracks, Rev Eric Ang. The meeting also heard Rev Dr Chris Chia (Vice-President) share about the challenges that many churches are facing in the area of Preschool Ministries.

The Exco has submitted an appeal to the authorities to help address some major difficulties for churches operating Preschool Ministries. We thank God for this opportunity to continue laying sound and solid foundations for young lives in our society.
